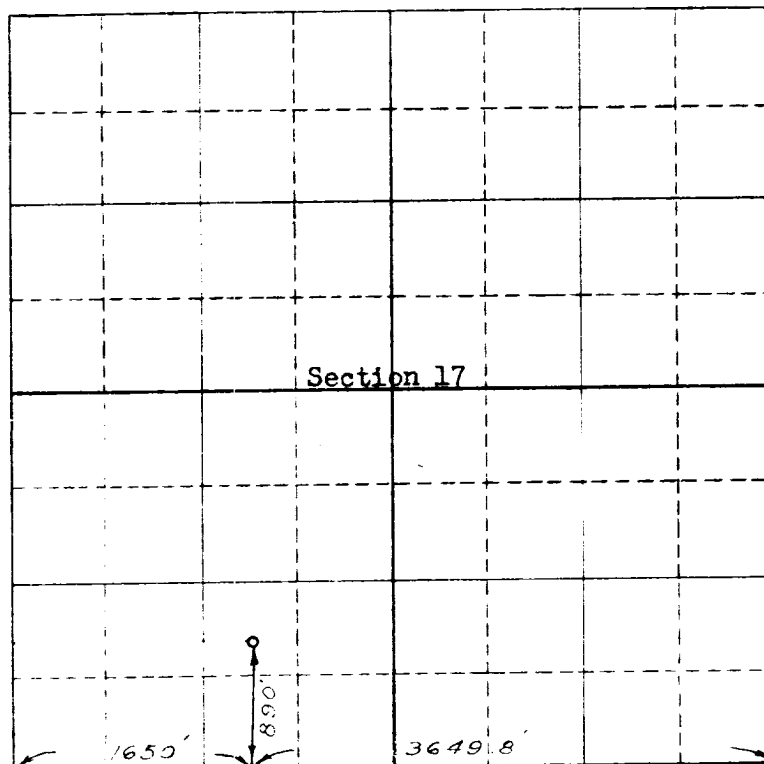

Dear Sir:

This unit is the south half of Section 17, Twp. 30N, Rge. 8W, San Juan County. The lease comprises 200 acres of patented land, the surface of which is owned jointly by Charles W. Maddox and Archie G. McCoy. This 200 acres consists of the southeast quarter and the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 17. The mineral interest of this 200 acres of patented land is divided as follows:

155 acres are owned jointly by Charles W. Maddox and Archie G. McCoy, and 45 acres are owned by Leo R. Manning.

The lease on the 200 acre unit is owned jointly by Anderson-Prichard Oil Corporation (one half), and Johnston Oil & Gas Company and William G. Johnston (one half).

The balance of this 320 acre unit is a federal lease and is owned by El Paso Natural Gas Company. There is 120 acres of this lease, which is located as follows:

North half of the southwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 17, Twp. 30N, Rge. 8W. This federal lease is covered by the following lease numbers:

Santa Fe 078578-A covers the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter, and Santa Fe 078596 covers the west half of the southwest quarter of Section 17.
