DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Spudding date November 13, 1953. November 14, 1953 ran 227' 10-3/4" 32.75# H-40 ss. casing. Landed @ 237'. Cemented with 175 sac reg. cement. Circulated cement to surface. Plug jumped to 175'. Let cement set 24 hrs. Picked up BP and bit. Ran to top of plug @ 160'. Closed BOP. Pressured casing and BP equipment with 1000#. Held pressure 15 min. No loss of pressure no leaks. Dr. cement. Closed BOP. Pressured with 900#. Held pressure 15 min., no leaks. November 22, 1953 ran 4194' 7" OD 20# J-55 ss. casing. Landed at 4177'. Cemented with 250 sac. Pressured casing with 1000# pressure 10 min. No leaks. Dr. cement plugs. Closed BOP. Pressured with 900#. Held 10 min. No leaks.

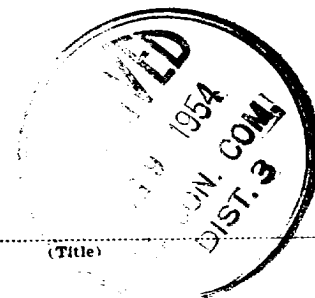
