We intend to complete this well in the Mesaverde formation at an approximate depth of 5600 feet.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION (If recompletion give full details of proposed plan of work.) It is proposed to drill with rotary to the top of the Mesaverde formation, estimated to be at a depth of 4600', and thereafter to drill with gas through the Mesaverde or to the top of the Mancos shale. It is further proposed to selectively sand-oil frac the Cliffhouse and Point Lookout formations. The N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Section is designated as the drilling unit.

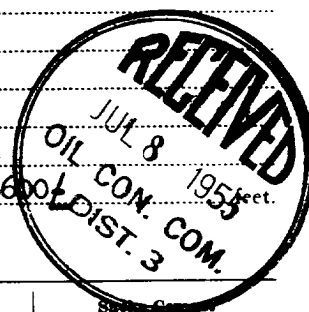

Lease Pubco et al State Well No. 19

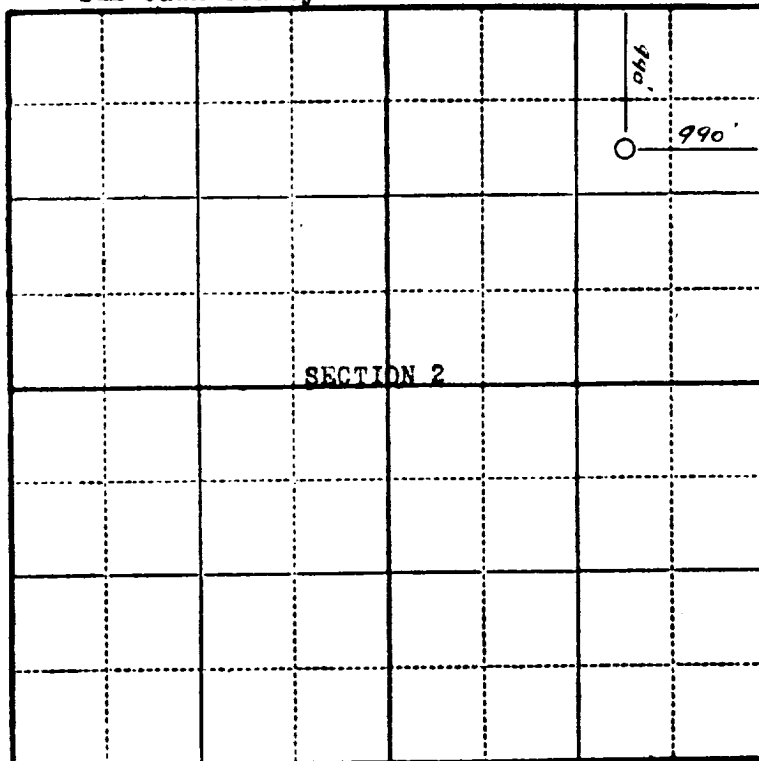
