We have received two copies of Federal Notice of Intent to Drill for your Simmons #6 located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 24-29N-9W. The acreage is shown as 160 acres in this quarter; however our dependent survey plat dated 1955 indicates there are only 146.24 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$. We are therefore correcting your acreage for this well. This will also necessitate the approval of non-standard unit. This may be done by writing Mr. A. L. Porter, Jr. Box 2088 Santa Fe, New Mexico.

From the last several notices you have filed I have decided you do not have a copy of the re-survey plat mentioned above. These plats may be secured from the Bureau of Land Management, Federal Building, Santa Fe, New Mexico.
