

After reviewing the information you supplied, we agree with the allocation factors as proposed. As such, you are hereby authorized to use fixed allocation factors as outlined below:

Formation	<u>Gas</u>	<u>Oil</u>
Mesaverde	75%	80%
Dakota	25%	20%

Commingled production from each zone must be reported in accordance with these established allocation factors. The effective date of commingling will be the date commingling first occurs.
