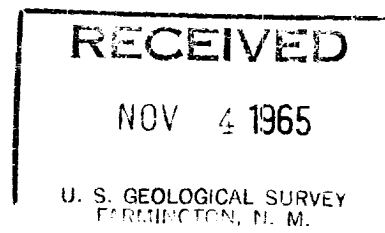
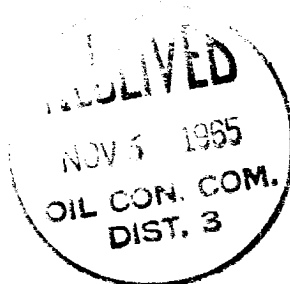

Referring to our report of August 28, 1965, the subject Wood Oil Unit No. 1 was alternately pump tested and shut-in for fluid level buildup until October 26, 1965 when all load oil was recovered. Alternately pump tested and shut-in well for fluid buildup continued until October 29, 1965 when well was treated with a mixture of 600 gallons of Methanol, 400 gallons of fresh water, 110 gallons of Jet Flow No. 200, 10 gallons of Jet Break No. 30, and 20 gallons of Jet Sperse No. 6182, and was flushed with 20 barrels water. Well shut-in 48 hours and testing resumed.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
