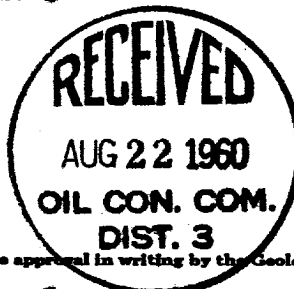

DETAILS OF WORK

**Total depth 5270' plug back depth 5230', Run Electric log. Set 5-1/2" casing at 5270' with 100 sacks 6 percent gel cement with 1-1/2 pounds Tuf Plug per sack, followed by 100 sacks neat cement. Received full circulation. After waiting on cement, tested 5-1/2" casing with 3,000 psi for 15 minutes which held with no indication of pressure drop. Released rig August 17, 1960. Preparing for Gully completion operations.**
