Dear Mr. Arnold:

We enclose herewith gas well plats showing dedicated acreage for Northeast Blanco Unit Wells No. 23-6 and 31-7 (three (3) copies each).

Our approved Request for Gas Allowable forms (Form C-104) were stamped by your office as being received on July 26, 1955 for Well No. 31-7 and on September 29, 1955 for Well No. 23-6.

The Oil Conservation Commission's standard gas well plat is not appropriate to the acreage dedicated to Wells No. 23-6 and 31-7 because the acreage consists of a part of two sections for each well. Therefore, this company has created a Northeast Blanco Unit map showing only the narrow tier of sections in Townships 30 and 31 North, Range 7 West. These maps or plats are submitted in lieu of the Commission's standard form.

It is requested that a temporary gas allowable be granted for Wells No. 23-6 and 31-7 based on the dedicated acreage as shown by the enclosed plats.
