Set approximately 5550' of 5-1/2" 15.50# J55 production casing and cement with approximately 150 sacks Ideal Regular cement.

Perforate the Point Lookout, Menafee and Cliffhouse zones separately and sandfrac each zone with approximately 60,000 gals water and 80,000 lbs sand.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

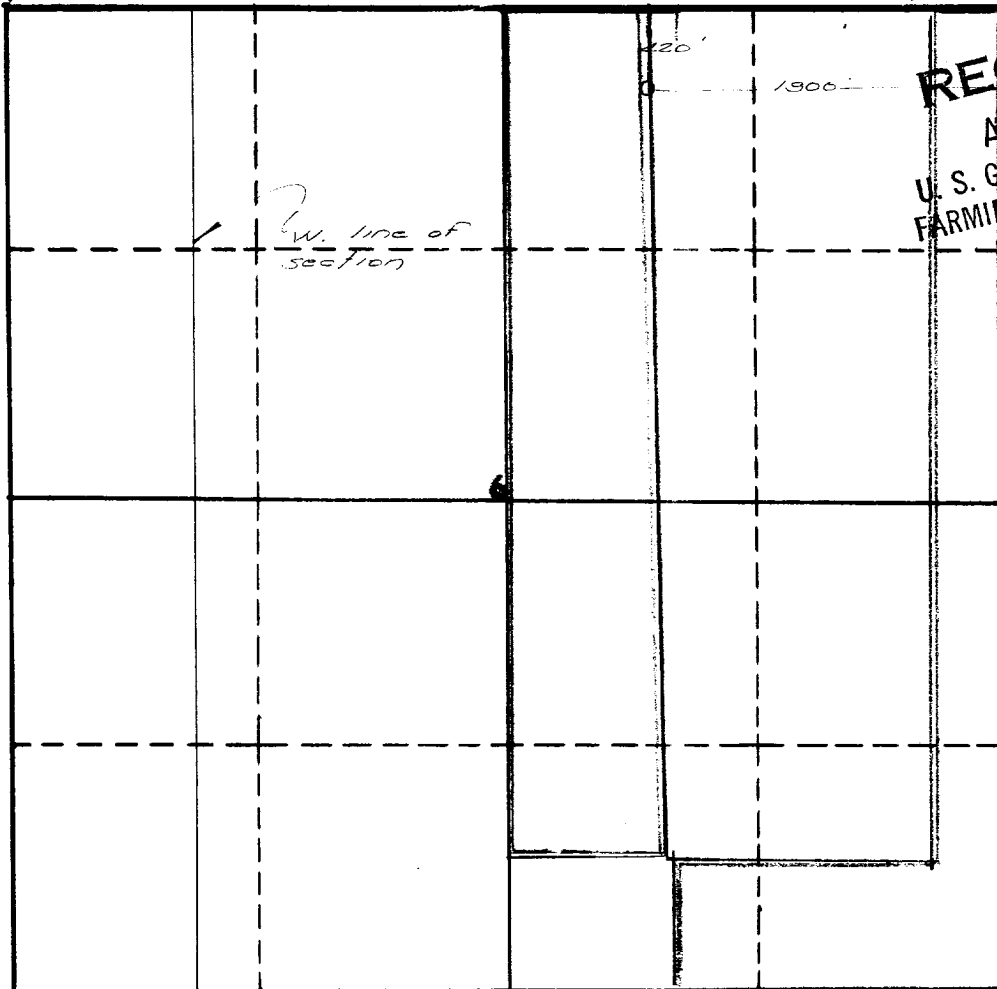
