Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a non-standard well location for your Northeast Blanco Unit, to be located 420 feet from the North line and 1900 feet from the East line of Section 6, Township 30 North, Range 7 West, Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the request for such exception is based upon extreme topographic relief and the advent of flooding the standard location by the proposed Navajo Dam in the NE/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as you are the only offset operator, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 1, Section (c) of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-110, as amended by Order R-397, you are hereby granted an exception to Order R-110, Section (c), for the above described unorthodox well location.
