
Dear Mr. Speer:

New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order R-3669 issued January 30, 1969, established a non standard proration unit for Pictured Cliffs gas production consisting of lots 6, 10, 11, 12 and 13 and E/2NW of Section 30, Township 29 North, Range 9 West. On August 19, 1970, Notice of Intention to Drill was filed for your Gerk Gas Com D #1 and reference was made to the approval of the non standard unit by order R-3669. On August 24, 1970, we inadvertently issued NWU 3-339 in error purporting to approve the unit and failed to properly describe the unit.

I am therefore voiding NWU 3-339 and request that you void your copy to prevent future confusion.
