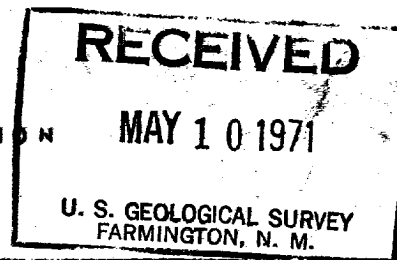


NEW MEXICO OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

All distances must be from the outer boundaries of the Section



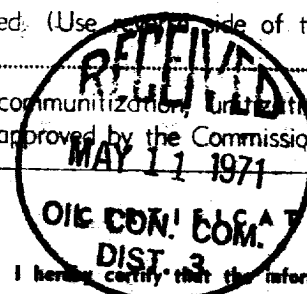

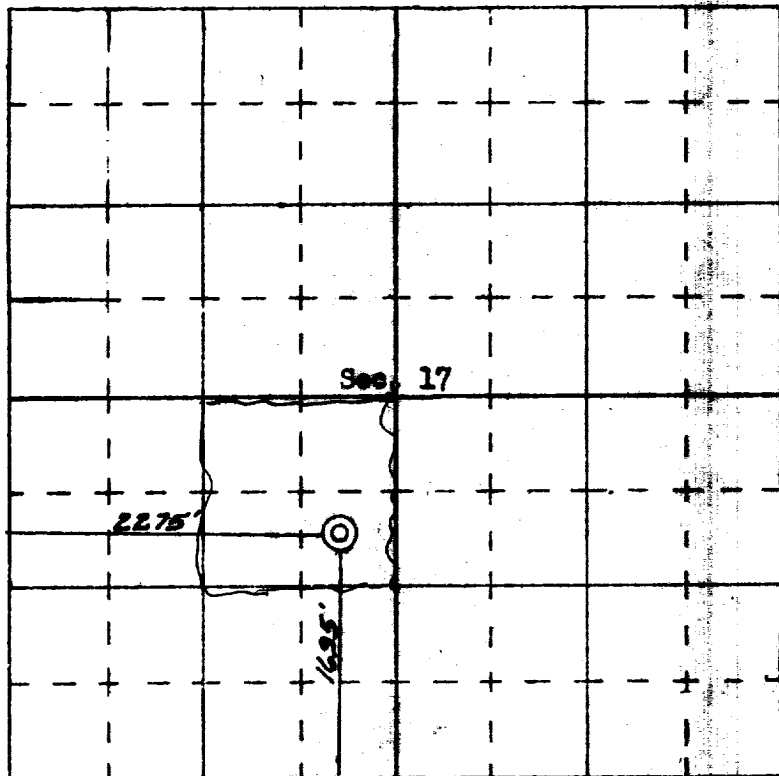
