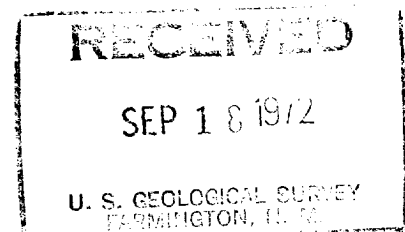

Picked up 4 3/4" bit, blew hole down and drilled wooden plug and cementing guide shoe, laid down bit, picked up core bbl. and 3 3/4" core head, cut core #1 657-663' - 6' recovered (1' tight shaly sandstone, 5' sandstone gray, fine-medium grain, good porosity and permeability, good odor). Blowing good stream of oil from hole, last 2' cored, had good odor after coring first foot. Well was flowing to surface after 7 hours, estimated 2 1/2 - 3 bbls. per hour.

Ran 20 jts. 2 3/8" O.D., 8Rd., 4.7#, J-55, "8" condition casing. T.E. 633.42' set at 632 G.L. - Well complete 12:00 noon, 9-9-72.
