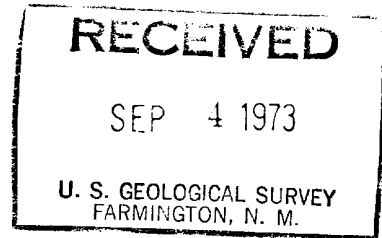

Enclosed are the maps and plat for the development and drilling of the Jerry McCutchin well in Section 31, Township 29 North Range 16 West, San Juan County New Mexico.

1. Existing roads including location of the exit from the main highway.

Attached is a map showing roads, pipelines, and telephone lines. No new roads will be built and very minor repairs on existing roads. Only new road is one (100') hundred feet.

2. Planned access roads.

There will be no construction. The new road will be used as in present condition.

5. Location of tank batteries and flow lines.

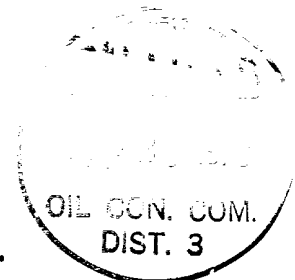
Unable to determine tank battery location until production is determined.

Water will be acquired from the San Juan River or Chaco wash over existing roads.

All waste material (Cuttings, Garbage, trash etc.) from the drilling will be disposed of in the pit and covered upon completion of the well.

This location is a slight slope to the Northeast. There is no cut to be made, only leveling for the pit and airstrip. There is very little vegetation on the soil in this area.
