

THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL  
GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2173

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on December 18, 1974, for permission to dually complete its Nye Well No. 14 located in Unit J of Section 8, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Fruitland Formation and from the Chacra Formation.

NOW, on this 20th day of December, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage.
- (3) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Nye Well No. 14 located in Unit J of Section 8, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Fruitland Formation and from the Chacra Formation through parallel strings of 2 7/8 inch casing cemented in a common well bore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT  
OF THE OIL COMPLETION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 11.1 of the Oil and Gas Commission, the Commission has the honor to acknowledge the receipt of the application of the applicant for a well completion in Unit 1 of Section 8, Township 29 North, Range 14 West, T12N, R14W, 2nd East Quarter, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Permian Formation and from the Ghara Formation.

Now, on this day of November, 1961, the Commission, after considering the application, finds:

- (1) That the applicant has been duly qualified under the provisions of Rule 11.1-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
- (2) That satisfactory tests have been conducted and that there are no other operators of offset wells.
- (3) That the proposed well completion will not cause water or waste correlative risks.
- (4) That the completion of the proposed well complies with the provisions of the proposed well completion provisions.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, Inc., the same is hereby authorized to fully complete the well in Unit 1 of Section 8, Township 29 North, Range 14 West, T12N, R14W, 2nd East Quarter, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Permian Formation and from the Ghara Formation through a well of 3 1/2" diameter, cemented in a common well bore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the applicant shall comply with the provisions of Rule 11.1 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that the applicant shall file a proper lease with the Commission and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That completion of this well is hereby retained for the benefit of such further order as the Commission may deem necessary.
