
Dear Sir:

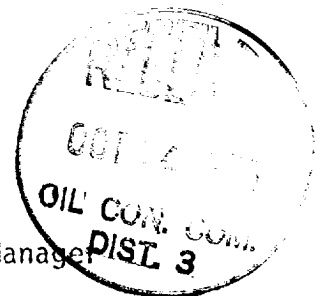

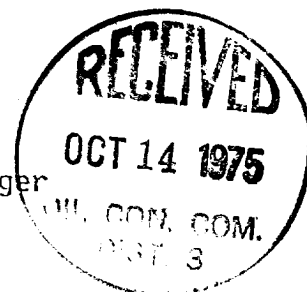

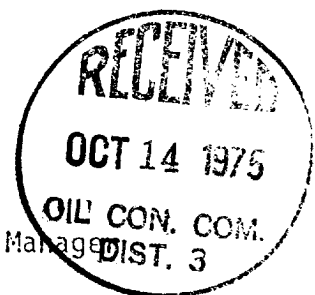
