
Dear Mr. Ramey:

The unorthodox location is due to Largo Wash as shown on the attached map.

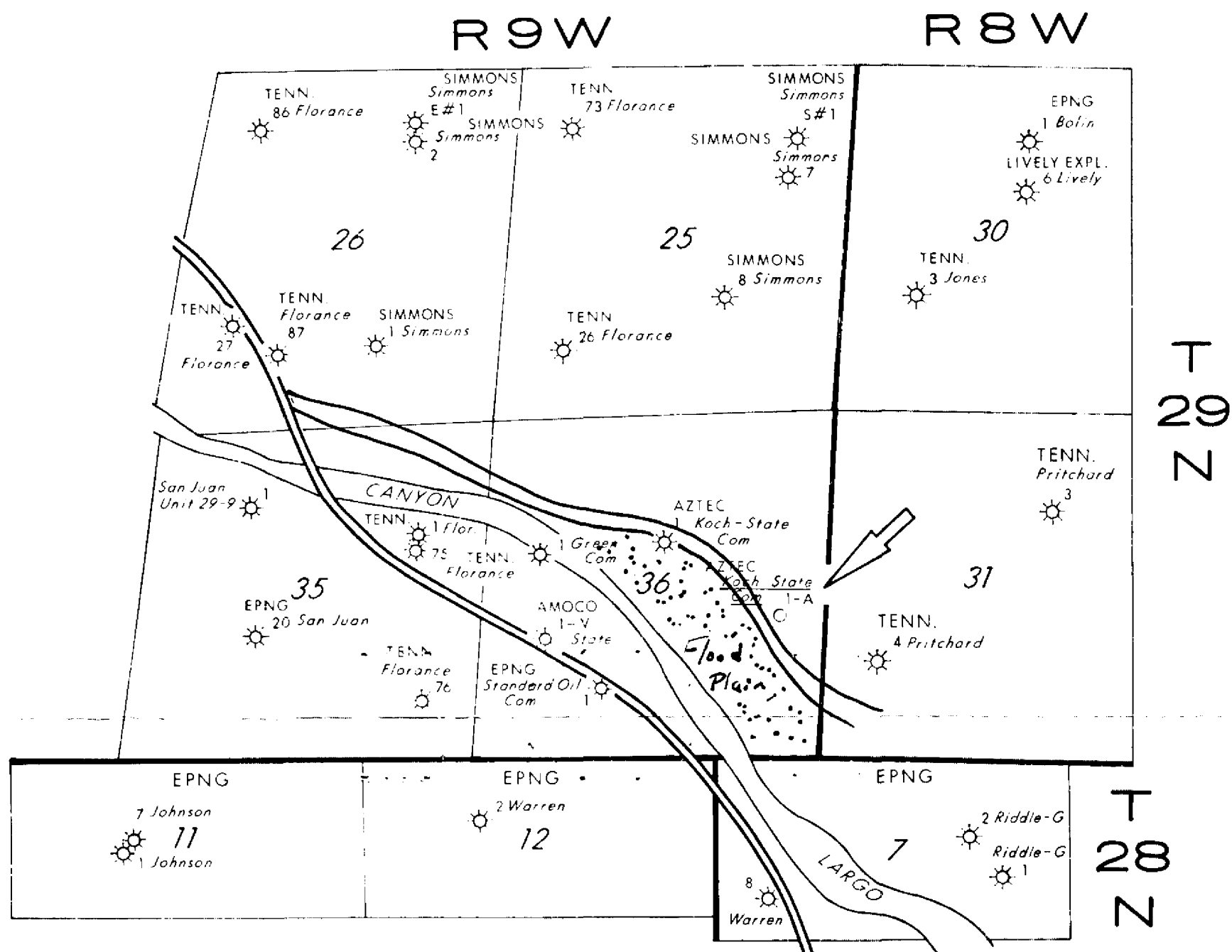
