All equipment has been moved from the location of the Howell J #3A (Unit Letter O, Sec. 11, T30N, R08W) to the Howell E #2 (Unit Letter A, Sec. 14, T30N, R08W). The reason for this move is to reduce the possibility of an oil spill in the Quality Water of the San Juan River. This change will require that the gas meter be 1800' away from the well-head. Meridian Oil would like to request your approval for off lease measurement, as we feel that this is a very environmentally sound improvement. Attached is a drawing of both locations after construction.
