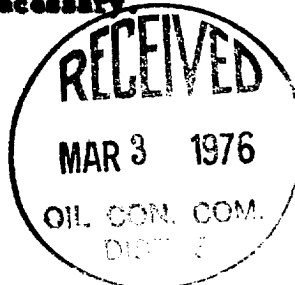

Will set 5 1/2" casing through boulders at approximately 40' with cable tools. Will then move rotary rig on location and drill 4 3/4" to 950' to test Pictured Cliff formation. If appears productive, will run 2 7/8" casing and cement. Will then perforate and test and stimulate if necessary.

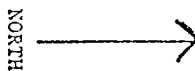
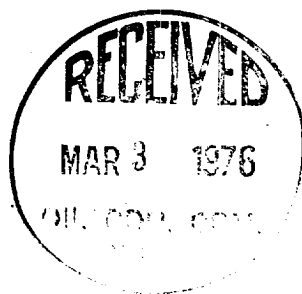
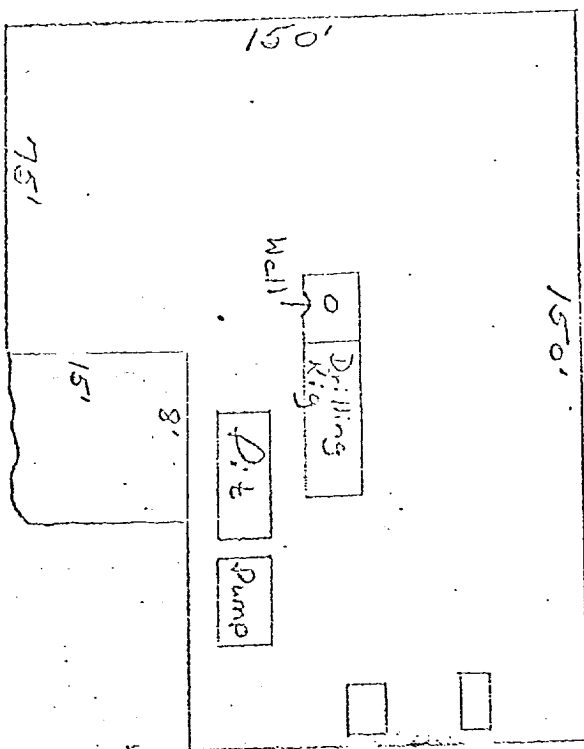


DEVELOPMENT PLAN
