## CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

 Plugging operations authorized are subject to the attached "General Requirements for Permanent Abandonment of Wells on Federal Leases".

2. The Farmington office (telephone (505) 325-4572) is to be notified in sufficient time for a representative to witness all plugging operation

3. Blowout prevention equipment is required.

- 4. In addition to normal filling of pits and cleanup of location, additional surface restoration work may be required, i.e. ripping of pad and/or access road, reseeding, etc. We have asked the Bureau of Land Management for the surface restoration requirements for this well and we should be able to furnish you these requirements within 30 days.
