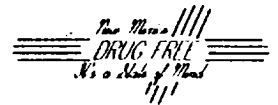

Dear Mr. McMillan:

New Mexico Oil Conservation Order R-8952 (for the protection of migratory birds) became effective June 15, 1989 and states that all pits and open tanks more than 16' in diameter shall be screened, netted or covered.

On June 28, 1993 field inspections revealed that the above mentioned pits contained standing oil or emulsion. In order for these pits to be in compliance, you are hereby directed to remove all fluid or properly net these pits by August 2, 1993.
