
Dear Mr. McGrath:

As requested by your office, the Surface Use Development plan for H. J. Loe Federal B No. 2-X, San Juan County, New Mexico, is as follows:

- Existing roads and exit to the location are shown on the attached plats.
- 2. No new access road will be required since the well location adjoins an existing road and location.
- 3. Offset wells to the proposed well are shown on the attached plat.
- 4. The flowline for subject well will run approximately 150' south to an existing battery at the edge of the location.
- 5. Water for drilling operations will be trucked from an existing canal located 2 miles east of the location. Water will be transported over existing roads as shown on the attached plats.
- 6. No additional construction material will be required.
- 7. All waste material will be contained by earthen and steel pits. Earthen pits will be subsequently backfilled and buried. A portable chemical toilet will be furnished for drilling personpole.
