Dear Mr. Kendrick:

Enclosed please find a C-104 "Request for Allowable and Authorization to Transport Oil and Natural Gas" for the Caribou Four Corners, Inc., Kirtland #1.

Caribou Four Corners, Inc., is requesting a temporary 60 day production period to determine the amount of associated gas which will be produced. Caribou Four Corners, Inc., proposes to market oil produced during completion and the temporary production period and hold all proceeds in an escrow account until final details on the Communitization Agreement and Division Order are completed.

During completion, swabbing the well yielded a visual estimate of 100 FCFPD. Shut-in casing pressure is in the 700 psi range. Caribou Four Corners, Inc., would like to produce the well for up to 60 days gauging the gas flared to the pits to determine the viability of obtaining a gas market.

El Paso's nearest gathering systems are north of Highway 550 or South of the San Juan River. Another possible gas outlet would be directly into Southern Union's distribution system. In order to determine the best course of action, a temporary production period of up to 60 days is requested.


Dear Mr. Kendrick:

Dear Mr. Kendrick:

The Kirtland #1 well was started flowing on July 13, 1979. The well was flowed a total of 14 days in July during the daylight hours. Approximately 800 barrels of oil were produced by flowing the well. Five hundred barrels of oil were hauled, by Inland Corporation, to the Caribou Four Corners refinery. A total of 566.67 barrels of oil have been marketed from the well during June and July.

It is my understanding that the payments for the oil will be made on August 22, 1979. Deposits will be made in the escrow account at the Farmington National Bank upon receipt of payment.

The USGS has yet to process the communitization agreement; USGS personnel have suggested it will take an additional 60 days for the agreement to be processed by the BIA and Navajo Tribe.

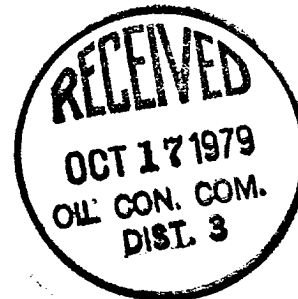

Dear Royalty Owners:

Caribou Four Corners, Inc., has been actively producing the Kirtland #1 well since July 13, 1979. The cumulative production sold through October 31, 1979, is 5393 barrels of oil. The total proceeds from this well are being deposited as required by the State of New Mexico, in an escrow account #70-303-6 at Farmington National Bank, P. O. Box 630, Farmington, NM 87401. Caribou Four Corners, Inc., has been and will continue to deposit all proceeds from this well's production into the above account at Farmington until the Federal Government and the Navajo tribe approve or disapprove the inclusion of 2.87 acres of Navajo land in the well's 80 acre spacing unit. This means that all funds are deposited- your royalty as well as Caribou's.


