ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Southland Royalty Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on March 28, 1980, for permission to dually complete its Hare Well No. 19 E located in Unit C of Section 23, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Mesaverde formation adjacent to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 18th day of April, 1980, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southland Royalty Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complet its Hare Well No. 19 E located in Unit C of Section 23, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Mesaverde formation adjacent to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.
