Dear Ms. Silseth:

The Bradenhead Test conducted on September 20, 1999, was not submitted until December 21, 1999, violating the five day reporting requirement. The information indicates the well is not in compliance with Rule 108.

Rule 108 "If any well appears to have a defective casing program or faultily cemented or corroded casing which will permit or may create underground waste or contamination of fresh waters, the operator shall give written notice to the Division within five (5) working days and proceed with diligence to use the appropriate method and means to eliminate such hazard. If such hazard of waste or contamination of fresh water cannot be eliminated, the well shall be properly plugged and abandoned."

In order to comply with Rule #108, prevent waste and protect fresh water, you are hereby directed to initiate remedial activity before March 15, 2000. Notify the Aztec OCD 24 hours before work is initiated.
