Reference is made to your application for non-standard Gallegos Canyon Unit Well locations, Basin Dakota Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, as follows:

Gallegos Canvon Unit Well No. 93E located 1725 feet from the South line and 590 feet from the West line of Section 36, Township 29 North, Range 12 West;

Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 173E located 635 feet from the West line and 1925 feet from the North line of Section 29, Township 29 North, Range 12 West;

Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 174E located 1450 feet from the North line and 410 feet from the West line of Section 28, Township 28 North, Range 12 West;

Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 184E located 400 feet from the South line and 630 feet from the East line of Section 28, Township 28 North, Range 12 West;

Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 185E located 825 feet from the North line and 775 feet from the East line of Section 33, Township 28 North, Range 12 West; and

Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 186E located 1250 feet from the South line and 1860 feet from the West line of Section 33, Township 28 North, Range 12 West. By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 3 of Order No. R-1670-V, the above-described unorthodox locations are hereby approved.
