

THE APPLICATION OF ENERGY RESERVES  
GROUP FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION



Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Energy Reserves Group made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on July 7, 1980, for permission to dually complete its Gallegos Canyon Unit Well #307 located in Unit L of Section 30, Township 29 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs-Formation and inject water in the Mesaverde-Formation.

Now, on this 8th day of December, 1980, the Division Director finds:

1. That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
3. That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
4. That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
5. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Energy Reserves Group, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Gallegos Canyon Unit Well #307 located in Unit L of Section 30, Township 29 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured-Cliffs Formation and inject water in the Mesaverde-Formation through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
