The Pierce A #2E will soon be commingled downhole as per the above administrative order DHC-742. We recommend production allocation as follows:

Gas: 24% Gallup
76% Dakota

Oil: 50% Gallup
50% Dakota

This allocation is based on actual production from both zones during December, 1989; 47 MCFD and zero oil from the Dakota and 15 MCFD and zero oil from the Gallup.
