- (6) That there are substantial differences in ownership of interests between the two 160-acre tracts which would be included in a standard 320-acre dedication in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.
- Blanco-Mesaverde Pool in the seven proposed non-standard chare in production from the subject matter of this application share in production from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.
- Blanco-Mesaverde well will result in a dilution of the interest That requiring the rededication of 320 acres to each
- (9) That there is a wide variation in production from the Blanco-Mesaverde wells which would comprise the new 320-acre
- the applicant the opportunity to produce his just and equitable the applicant the opportunity to produce his just and equitable share of the gas in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, Will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an

excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

(1) That seven non-standard gas proration units in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, are hereby established and dedicated to wells as follows:
