ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER' OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Tenneco Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on December 8, 1980, for permission to dually complete its Sullivan Frame Com B No. 1 located in Unit D of Section 30, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of Bloomfield Chacra and Undesignated Mesaverde gas.

Now on this 29th day of December, 1980, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provied that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause wase nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Tenneco Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Sullivan Frame Com B No. 1 located in Unit D of Section 30, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of Bloomfield Chacra and Undesignated Mesaverde gas through parallel strings of tubing.

 $$\tt PROVIDED\ HOWEVER}$, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.$ 

 $\underline{\text{PROVIDED FURTHER}}, \ \text{That applicant shall take packer-leakage}$  tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.


