Dear Frank,

We would like to flow test the Dakota zone in this dual Chacra/Dakota completion for a period of 3 days and flare it to atmosphere. The above well has never been able to produce to Sunterra Gas Gathering's line due to the high line pressure. We will flow the Dakota zone to atmosphere and hold 90 psi backpressure to simulate the line pressure of Union Texas Petroleum's Rudy gathering system. This flow test will enable us to determine if we can justify the cost of connection to our gathering system, and produce this well to recover additional reserves.

We anticipate beginning this 3 day test on Monday, October 5, 1987.
