Exception to No-Flare
Pollock Com E No. 1
Unit P, Section 28, T29N, R10W
San Juan County, New Mexico

We are requesting a temporary exception to the No-Flare Rule for the subject well in order to kick the well off and perform a potential test. The Mesaverde formation in the Pollock Com E No. 1 was completed in December of 1984. Initial production from this formation averaged 160 BWPD with no gas or oil. A remedial cement squeeze was performed in order to shut off this water flow in May of 1985. We would like to perform a one week production test and repotential this well in order to connect it to the pipeline.
