Dear Bill:

Reference is made to your application dated October 1, 1991 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Pollock Com "E" Well No. 1 which was drilled in 1983 and dually completed in the Armenta Gallup Oil Pool and Blanco Mesaverde Pool at a standard location for both zones 860 feet from the South line and 805 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 28, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that both the Gallup and Mesaverde zones will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, is unorthodox. Further, the E/2 of said Section 28 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.

Amoco Production Company hereby requests administrative approval for an unorthodox well location in the Basin Fruitland Coal Pool. Amoco plans to recomplate the existing Pollock Com E-1 Well from the Gallup and Mesaverde formations to the Fruitland Coal formation. This well is currently uneconomic and would be abandoned if not utilized for recompletion. The location of the well is 860' FSL and 805' FEL of Section 28-T29N-R10W. Although this location is orthodox for the Armenta Gallup and Blanco Mesaverde pools, it is unorthodox in the Basin Fruitland Coal Pool due to the required NE-SW pattern. All existing wells in the orthodox location are currently economic producers and are not candidates for recompletion.

A copy of this application will be submitted to the offset operators by certified mail with a request that they furnish your Santa Fe office with a Waiver of Objection, and return one copy to this office. Attached is a plat showing the location of the well and offset operators and a plat showing all wells drilled in the section.

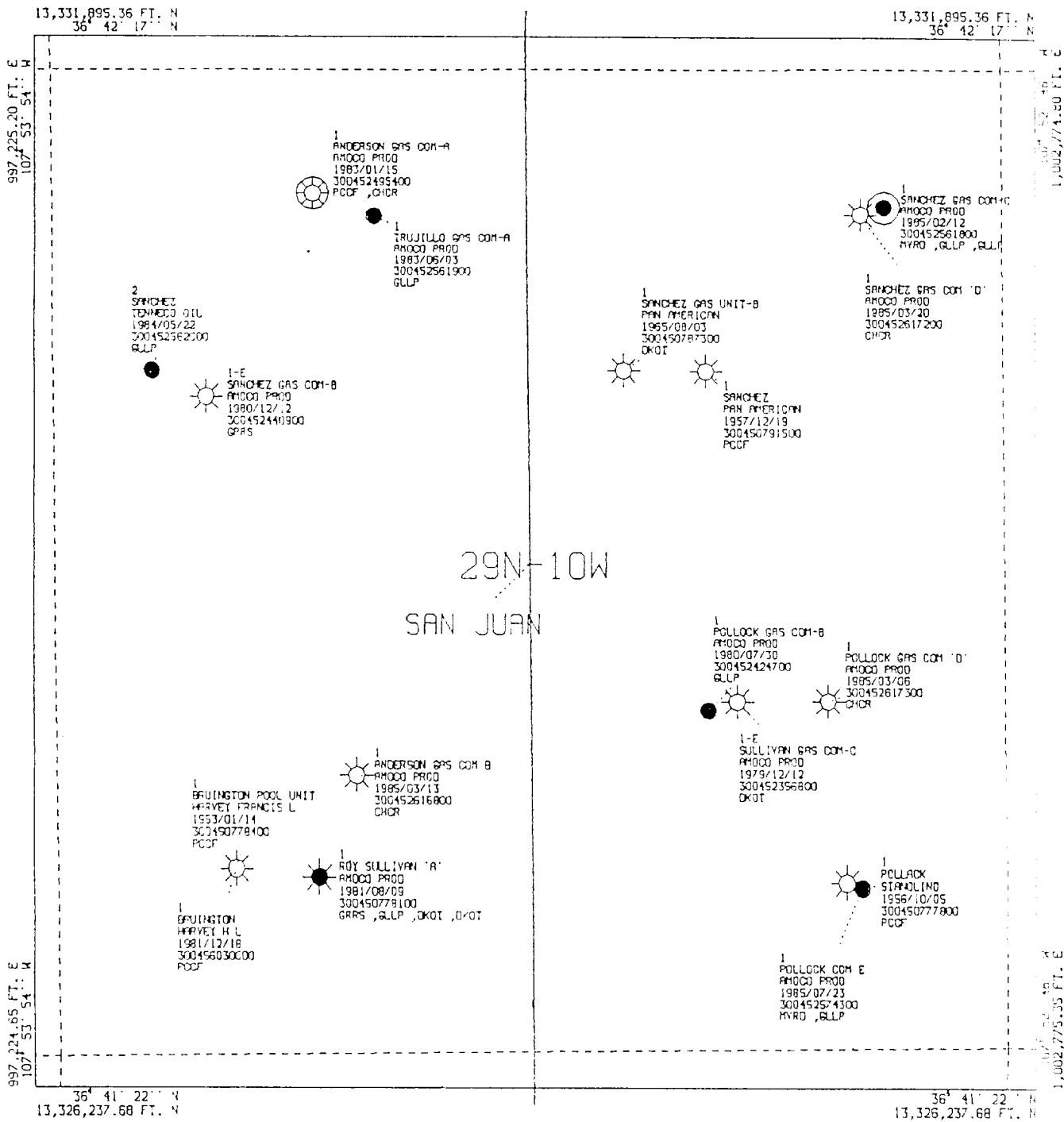

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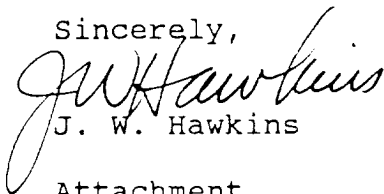
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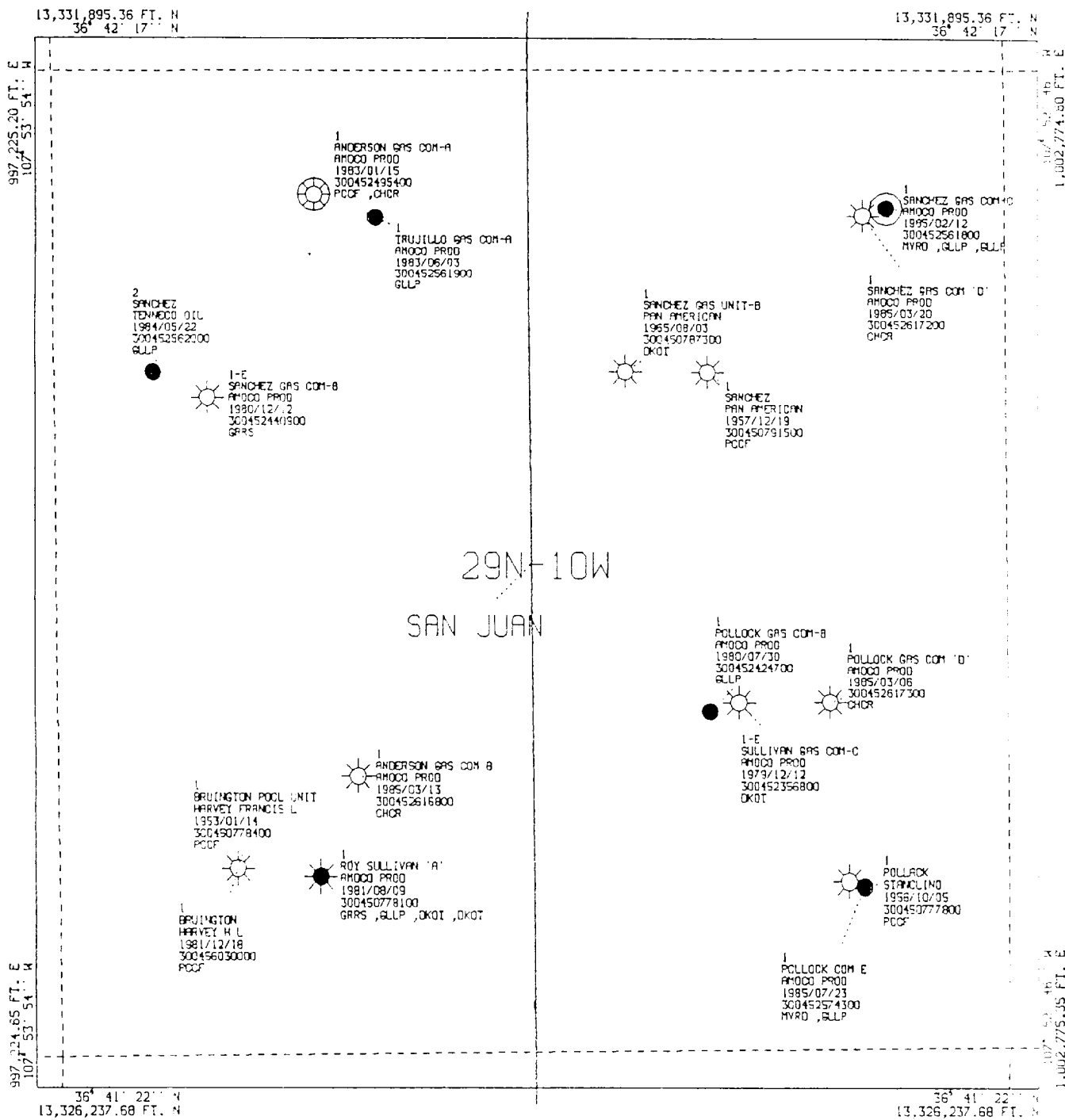
