Dear Phil:

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 105 of the Division Rules and Regulations, the request for off site disposal of drilling fluid and cuttings from the above referenced well, to the construction site, belonging to Dawn Trucking Co., is granted with the following provisions:

- That only the drilling fluid and cuttings from the above referenced well be disposed of the approved site.
- 2. That the drilling fluid and cuttings be worked into the soil, and not just dumped on the surface.
- That every measure be taken to insure that the drilling fluid and cuttings be kept out of existing water channels.
- That the disposal site is approved for the above referenced well only.
