Gentlemen:

Exception to No-Flare Sanchez GC D#1 Unit A, Section 28, T29N, R10W San Juan County, New Mexico

We are requesting a temporary exception to the No-Flare Rule for the subject well in order to perform a Potential Test. The initial Potential Test on the subject well indicated a well deliverability below connection standards. There is reason to believe that the well's poor performance was due to liquid loading. We would like to perform another Potential Test in order to connect this well to the pipeline. The duration of the flow period will be 3 hours.

Based on recent production of an offset well, we estimate the gas production to be 75-100 mcfd.
