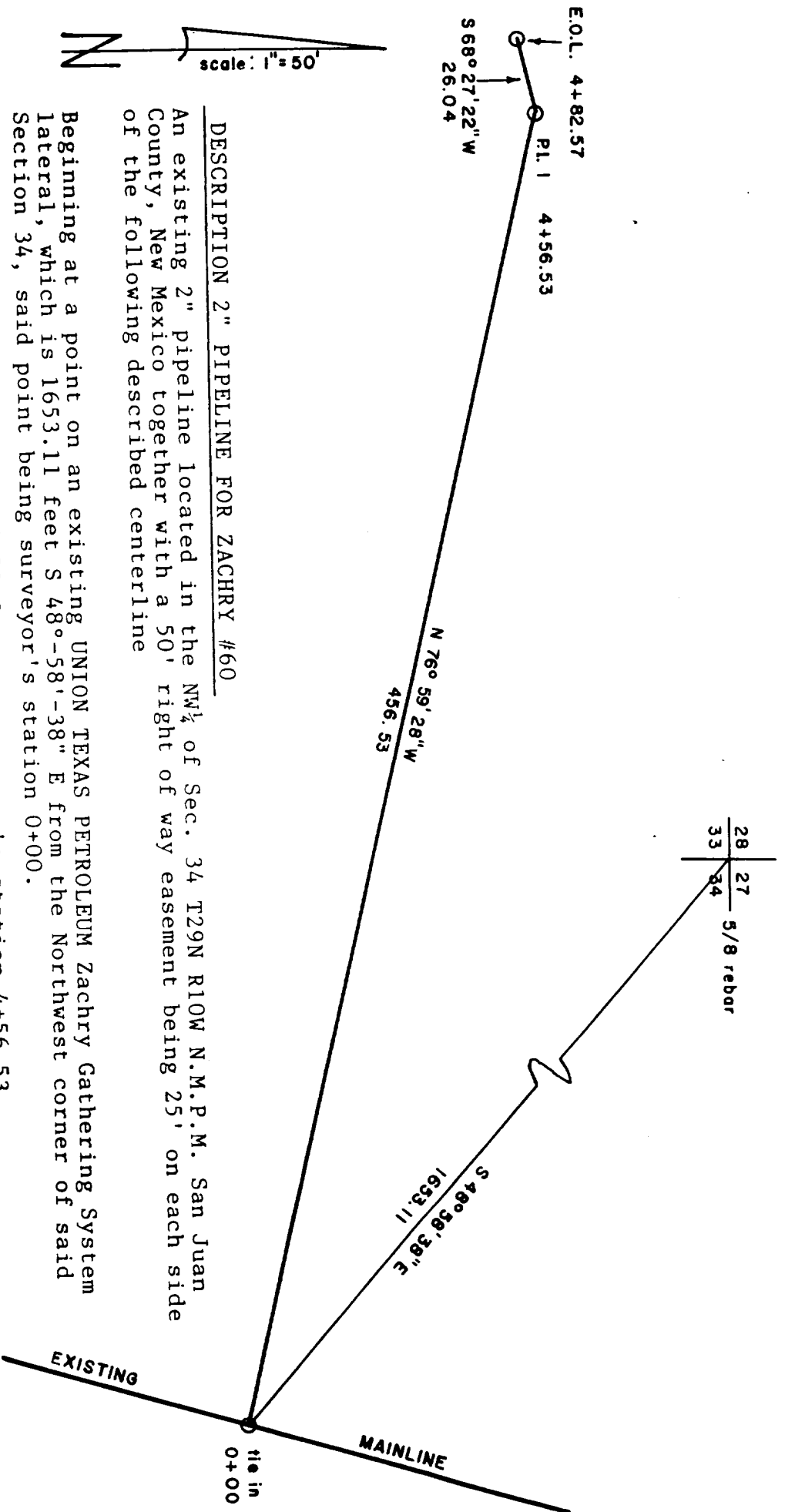

DESCRIPTION 2" PIPELINE FOR ZACHRY #60

An existing 2" pipeline located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 34 T29N R10W N.M.P.M. San Juan County, New Mexico together with a 50' right of way easement being 25' on each side of the following described centerline

Beginning at a point on an existing UNION TEXAS PETROLEUM Zachry Gathering System lateral, which is 1653.11 feet S 48°-58'-38" E from the Northwest corner of said Section 34, said point being surveyor's station 0+00.

THENCE: N 76°-59'-28" W 456.53 feet to surveyor's station 4+56.53  
THENCE: S 68°-27'-22" W 26.04 feet to surveyor's station 4+82.57 E.O.L. at an existing meter house.
