Spud date for subject well was 4-19-90 at 2:00pm. A 8 3/4" hole was drilled to 160'.  
7" 20# K-55 new csg. was set at 132'KB and cemented with 150 sks class "G". Had full  
returns with 4 1/2 bbl's of cement to surface.  
During the drilling of the surface hole BHP was advised by the City of Farmington that  
a Oil & Gas permit is required within the city limits. BHP requested to continue and  
secure the hole by running and cementing the surface csg. At that point BHP would move  
out and acquire the necessary city permints. The city permit was approved on June 26,  
1990. BHP is now waiting on a drilling contractor.
