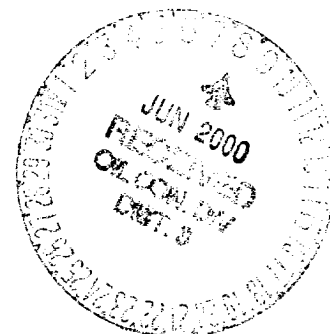

Reference is made to your request dated May 26, 2000 to increase the surface injection pressure on the above referenced well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on May 4, 2000. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

Gallegos Canyon Unit 13 Well No. 1	711 PSIG
Located in Section 13, Township 29 North, Range 13 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.	

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
