Dear Mr. Gowan:

Reference is made to your application dated June 15, 1993 for a non-standard coal gas well location for the ROPCO ^{fed.} ~~Fee~~ FC-5 Well No. 2 which was drilled in December 1992 and located 2015 feet from the South line and 1765 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 5, Township 29 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The S/2 of said Section 5 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
