Reference is made to your application dated February 22, 1994, for a non-standard gas well location for you Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 529 to be drilled 2119 feet from the South line and 1398 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 36, Township 29 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, Undesignated West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The SE/4 of said Section 36 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit.
