Reference is made to your application dated September 19, 1990 for a 225.44-acte non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool:

## RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, NMPM

Section 36: Lots 1 through 4, and the W/2 E/2 (E/2 equivalent)

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your San Juan 31-6 Unit Well No. 214 to be drilled at a standard coal gas well location 1560 feet from the North line and 831 feet from the East line (Unit G) of said Section 36.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland coal Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above non-standard gas proration unit is hereby approved.
