ADDITIONAL INFORMATION (If recompletion give full details of proposed plan of work.)

The above well was approved for drilling January 28, 1959, however has been delayed due to difficulties in effecting a unit with other operators. We now propose to drill the above well with rotary tools to an approximate total depth of 2500' to complete in the Pictured Cliffs formation. Stimulation will be as indicated on reaching total depth. Copies of location plat were attached to original Notice of Intention to Drill and are still applicable. Logs will be furnished upon completion of well.

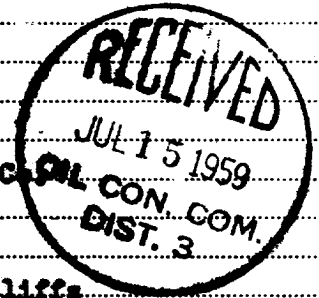
