Gentlemen:

Your attention is directed to the general letter issued January 24, 1955 by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission outlining the procedure to be followed for prorating gas in the San Juan Basin. As pointed out in the letter, certain wells in the San Juan Basin could not be classified as standard gas proration units, and these wells were indicated as non-standard units on the March gas proration schedule for the San Juan Basin. Further, the letter points out that all non-standard gas proration units must have either administrative approval or a hearing by May 1, 1955, in order to remain on the gas proration schedule.

Our records indicate that the following well operated by you is a non-standard unit for which we have received no application requesting approval of said non-standard unit.

Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool

State 14-M 36-30-9

Enclosed you will find a memorandum outlining the filing requirements necessary for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit. If application is not received by May 1, 1955 for the above listed non-standard gas proration unit, the well will be removed from the schedule and shut-in.

Your attention is directed to the fact that the general order issued January 21, 1955 by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission outlining the procedure to be followed for protecting gas in the San Juan Basin. As pointed out in the letter, certain wells in the San Juan Basin could not be classified as standard gas production wells, and these wells were indicated as non-standard on the list of wells for the San Juan Basin. Further, the letter states that a non-standard gas production well must have either administrative or a hearing by May 1, 1955, in order to remain on the gas production schedule.

The records reflect that the following well does not have a non-standard status for which we have received no application and only approval of the non-standard status.

San Juan Basin Gas Well
