DETAILS OF WORK

Run 111 joints of 7" O.D. 20# J-55 casing landed at 4520' (TD) with 265 sacks of regular cement with full return throughout job. Casing is set in top of Cliffhouse formation, cable tools with rotary attachment using gas will be moved in for Moss Verde completion, then well will be shot with 240. Water shut-off test will be made after drilling plug with cable tools.  
Present T.D. 4520'.
