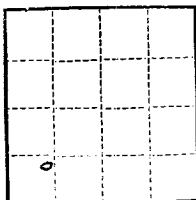

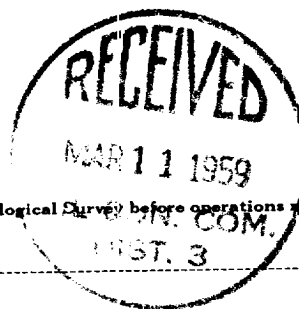
Plugs of neat cement set by Halliburton as follows (2-26-59):

(3-3/4" used 14" surface casing left at 10 feet)

10 sacks from 0-50 feet in surface cas with 1" pipe as marker

10 sacks from 1475-1480 feet (shut-off Halliburton gas sand)

10 sacks from 1487-1492 feet (shut-off Dickman Cliffs, topped at 1486, T 1492)
