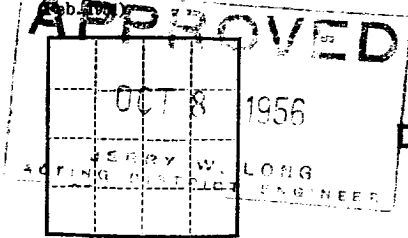

DETAILS OF WORK

The above well was spudded on August 2, 1956, and on August 8, 1956, 13-7/8" casing was set at 497 feet, cemented with 600 sacks cement. After waiting on cement for thirty hours, casing and water shut off were tested with 500 pounds pressure for thirty minutes with no drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.
