

THE APPLICATION OF TENNECO OIL
COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1672

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Tenneco Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 21, 1965, for permission to dually complete its Florence Well No. 2 located in Unit A of Section 20, Township 30 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 11th day of October, 1965, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Tenneco Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Florence Well No. 2 located in Unit A of Section 20, Township 30 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER. That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

provide as far as possible from the Bisbee-Mesa Verde Pool and the Basin-Dixie
Pool.

Now, on this day of October, 1925, the Secretary-

Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the
provisions of Rule 115-A of the Conservation's Rules and Regulations;
that this application information has been provided
by the operator of oil well service which the
operator has been issued a license;

(2) That the mechanics of the proposed unit combination
will not cause waste or imminent contamination with
the fissile and corrosive with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application herein, Tennessee Oil Company, be and
the same is hereby authorized to jointly complete the license
Unit No. 3 located in Unit A of Section 30, Township 30 North,
Range 9 New Mexico, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such manner as
to provide as far as possible from the Bisbee-Mesa Verde Pool and the Basin-Dixie
Pool, provided the said unit combination and the capital
respective.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That application shall take effect
unless delivered to the conservator and authority specified herein
