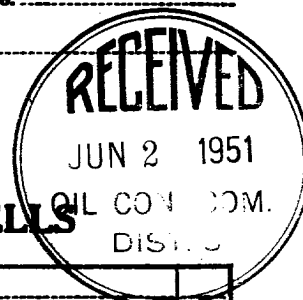

If, after shot and clean out, it is found necessary, 5" liner with perforations opposite Cliffhouse and Point Lohout Sandstones will be set from 4371' to T. D.

DETAILS OF WORK
