We have never received any subsequent reports on your well in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8-30N-11W regarding where production casing was set and cemented or any casing tests. We also have never received any shot record or Form C-105. Will you please submit the above forms and indicate what the present status of this well is. We would also like to know if you ever effected a water shut-off and if not, when and if you intend to do so.

It will be necessary for us to know this so that we may be able to instruct you as to what steps to take to properly plug this well, in case you do not intend to produce it. We are sending you, under separate cover, a set of Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission, revised January 1, 1953. We would like to call your attention specifically to Pages 38-41 for the rules concerning submittal of reports on wells drilled in the State of New Mexico
