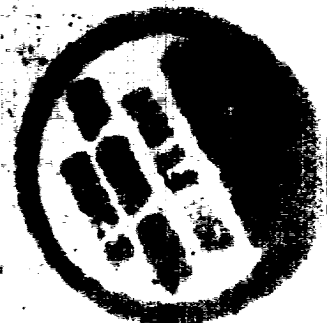

Re: 41 Petro-Alias Bolack Well

Dear Sir:

By Term No. 2-221a, dated July 21, 1956, we  
filled our intention to drill for our 41 Petro-Alias  
Bolack Well located 1980 feet from the west line and  
1450 feet from the south line of Sec. 9, T30N, R10W,  
NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. The necessity for  
this location was based on topographical considerations.  
The ownership of the oil and gas lease on the NW 1/4 of  
SE 1/4 of Sec. 9, the 40 acre unit on which the above well  
is located, is common with the ownership of the oil and  
gas lease on the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 9, the 40 acre  
unit to the south.

This well was completed as an oil well, produc-  
ing from the Gallup Sand, on September 1, 1956, and is  
an unorthodox location for an oil well as defined in  
Rule 104 of the Statewide Rules and Regulations, para-  
graph (b)(1), as revised on August 10, 1956.

We request approval from the Secretary of the  
Commission for the production of oil from the above 41  
Petro-Alias Bolack Well.
